AWOL All Walks of Life, inc. Summer Camp Disciplinary Policy

Summer camps are meant to be a time of fun, creativity and education. For the benefit of all campers, it is important that children behave appropriately within the summer camps. If it becomes necessary to take disciplinary action against a student, the following steps outlined here will be followed.

1st Incident-The camper will receive a verbal warning and an explanation as to why the behavior is inappropriate (whenever possible, this will be done in a one-on-one setting removed from other campers).

2nd Incident-Staff will determine an appropriate consequence for the camper's actions (examples may include "time out" or exclusion from participating in an activity). The camper's parent will be notified of their behavior when they arrive to pick up the child.

3rd Incident-The child will be excused from camp without a tuition refund.

AWOL, Inc. reserves the right to bar any child from summer camp following a first incident in cases of serious behavior problems that may endanger the safety of the child, other campers, staff/volunteers.
